Need Help with Transport?

Are you an older person who has difficulty getting to the doctors surgery or other medical appointments?

If you live in Sunningdale, Sunninghill or Ascot (including South Ascot & North Ascot) then Ascot Volunteer Bureau can provide a driver to take you to your medical appointments.

What we do

We are a local charity based in South Ascot organising transport to enable older local residents to get to appointments at hospitals, surgeries, dentists, opticians and other health related visits.

We take people to appointments both within the immediate area and also further afield, including London.

We are staffed completely by volunteers and currently have around 30 drivers.

We also have a team of office workers who answer the phones each weekday between 10 and 12, taking bookings and co-ordinating drivers.

How Much Does It Cost?

Clients pay the driver £4 for a local journey (e.g. to a local GP) or 45p a mile outside of this area, to cover their running costs for the journey.

Help may be given to those in receipt of income support or pension credit.

How we are funded

We are a non-profit organisation. Consequently we are dependent on grants and donations to cover our administration costs – office rental, telephone, postage, and other incidental costs.

We have been fortunate in receiving funding and donations from a number of sources over the years but are always looking for new ways to fund the organisation.
